

# Interior Wall Panel Use and Care

## 1. Use

• Where can the wall panels be used?

Wall Panels is a versatile product. It can be used as the interior and residential siding of houses, offices, restaurants, shops, etc. And it can be used in a moist place, such as in the shower room or kitchen.

• How to install the wall panels?

The wall panels can be installed to smooth flat surfaces such as Plaster, Drywall, Brick, and Concrete walls, using construction adhesive and finish straight nails.

With uneven and bumpy surfaces, the wall panel can be fixed on a wood framework using construction adhesive and nails.

## 2. Care

- Wall Panels are easy to clean. Don't worry about the mold building up on the panel surface. We recommend cleaning the wall panels regularly to remove dust and grime.
- Interior wall panels are not stable under ultraviolet light. Therefore, color fading may occur when the panels are subject to direct sunlight. Consequently, it is recommended that curtains or blinds are used during periods of prolonged or intense sunlight.

# 2.1 Cleaning Supplies

- Mild Dishwashing Liquid Soap
- Clean Water
- Vacuum Cleaner with a dust brush attachment or Dust Brush
- Lint-Free Cloths or Microfiber Cloths
- Bucket

### 2.2 Procedures

- Step 1: Wiping the walls to remove the dust and grime using the Vacuum Cleaner with a dust brush attachment or Dust Brush, then wipe the walls with the cloths or a cleaned Dust Brush again.
- Step 2: Mix the Mild Dishwashing Liquid Soap with clean water. Then soak the Cloths in the well-mixed cleaning solution and wring it out well.
- Step 3: Start cleaning at the top of the wall panels and work your way down.
- Step 4: Soak a Cloth in clean water and wring it out well. Wipe the wall panels with the cloth to rinse.
- Step 5: Use a clean and dry cloth to dry the wall. Get the wall panels without moisture.

#### **Please Note:**

- 1. Make sure you use the correct stain cleaner. Some cleaners can affect the look of your wall panels. These harsh cleaners may alter the wall panels' surface color.
- 2. You shouldn't wait long before you get rid of them. Immediate removal of the stains will make your wall panels easier to clean. Remove the stains as soon as you find them to retain the appearance of your wall panels.
- 3. Avoid using bleach, acid, or alkaline-based cleaners or compounds. It will erode and permanently discolor the decorative lamination surface.
- 4. Prohibit using abrasive cleaners, powders, scouring pads, steel wool, sandpaper, etc. These can damage the finish of the decorative surface.
